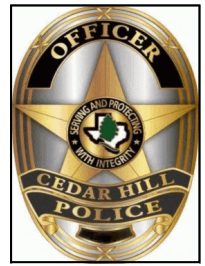

## Significant Investigation

On 5/13/2021, Ronald Taylor attempted to break into a residence in the 1700 block of Hartin Dr with an ax. His estranged wife was staying at that location at the time. Taylor threatened to kill her and the other occupant of the residence. Taylor was arrested for Burglary and Terroristic Threat. He was placed under a Family Protective Order and released on Bond.

On 5/24/2021 he returned to the location and forced entry into the house and shot the homeowner. The homeowner fought back physically and during this struggle, Taylor's wife hit him in the head with a dumbbell. This allowed she and the homeowner to escape the residence. Taylor was arrested again on charges of Burglary Intend Other Felony and Violate Bond/Protective Order.

On 8/10/2022, Taylor was sentenced to 20 years in prison.
