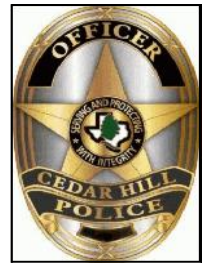

On 08/06/2022, Cedar Hill Officers responded to the 200 blk of W. Pleasant Run Rd. in reference to a burglary of a vehicle report. Officers were told that unknown suspect(s) entered the victim's vehicle and took the victim's credit/debit cards. After the property was taken, the victim's stolen credit cards were used at the Cedar Hill Wal-Mart.

During the investigation, Cedar Hill Detectives were given a suspect vehicle description. With that information they used the Flock Camera System and were able to get a license plate on the suspect vehicle. After further investigation into the vehicle's owner, Detectives were able to identify 2 suspects involved in the Burglary of a Vehicle and Credit Card Abuse offenses.

On 09/16/2022, Cedar Hill Detectives were able to locate and apprehend both suspects in a hotel in the City of Dallas. Both suspects were booked into the Desoto Jail for Burglary of a Vehicle and Credit Card Abuse warrants.
